What is the 10th Annual NYC Bowling for Breastcancer.org?

The 10th Annual NYC Bowling for Breastcancer.org bowl-a-thon on Wednesday, March 20, 2019, is an incredible networking event with close to 500 senior media and advertising professionals from agencies, marketers, and media companies. All proceeds from the evening benefit Breastcancer.org, a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing essential medical information for people affected by or concerned about breast cancer. To date, over \$4M has been raised by roughly 2,500 attendees, and over 350 advertisers, agencies and media companies have been represented.

When and where is the event happening?

The 10th Annual NYC Bowling for Breastcancer.org bowl-a-thon is scheduled for Wednesday, March 20, 2019 at Lucky Strikes Lanes & Lounge, 624-660 West 42nd Street, New York, NY.

What time does it start?

The 10th Annual NYC Bowling for Breastcancer.org bowl-a-thon is scheduled from 6:00 p.m. to 10 p.m.

Who can participate?

Bowl-a-thon attendees must be preregistered as part of a bowling or billiards team. General admission tickets are also available for purchase at www.bowlingforbreastcancer.org.

How do I register?

How much do general admission tickets cost?

Non-refundable general admission tickets are \$500 each. Visit www.bowlingforbreastcancer.org to purchase.

Is there a fundraising minimum?

No, there is no fundraising minimum. All bowling and billiard players are encouraged to ask friends to sponsor their score. Awards will be presented the night of the event to top fundraisers.

Can I form a bowling or billiards team?

Fundraising

How much money do I have to raise?

There is no fundraising minimum. Awards will be presented the night of the event to top fundraisers.

I've never raised money before. Can I do it?

Absolutely! Fundraising can be fun...and a lot easier than you may think. If I can't participate, do my donors get their money back?

No. All donations are non-refundable.

Can my donors get tax receipts?

Yes, all donors who make a donation in support of Breastcancer.org will get a tax receipt. Online donors will receive an automatic e-mail receipt after donating. People who donate via check will receive a receipt in the mail.

Is there a donation form on the website?

Do you accept donations by check?

Absolutely. Please make sure checks are made payable to "Breastcancer.org" and put the bowling or billiards team or player name in the "memo" line. Don't forget to send in a donation form with each check so you will be properly credited for the donation. Should a donation check be made payable to you, endorse the check on the back and, under your

signature, write "Pay to the order of Breastcancer.org." All checks should be mailed to Breastcancer.org headquarters at 120 East Lancaster Avenue, Ardmore, PA, 19003.

Can we submit donations in cash?

No, Breastcancer.org cannot accept cash donations.

How long does it take for donations to post to my Personal Page?

Donations that are made online will post to your Personal Page immediately. It may take up to 4 weeks for donations made by check to post to your Personal Page.

Can my team fundraise as a group?

Yes. Fundraising with your team can be lots of fun and a great way to maximize your fundraising efforts.

How do I get credited for matching gifts from a donor's employer?

Contact your employer's human resources department to find out if they have a matching gift program. Complete the necessary paperwork or online forms and forward them to Breastcancer.org headquarters at 120 East Lancaster Avenue, Ardmore, PA, 19003. After Breastcancer.org receives your matching gift form, we'll verify the gift and return it to your employer. Your employer will then send a check matching the donation directly to Breastcancer.org. This process can take several weeks, so please complete matching gift forms early to ensure proper crediting towards your fundraising goal.

Do matching gifts count towards my fundraising efforts?

Yes.

Registering Your Team

How do I register?

1. The captain of your team must register first at www.bowlingforbreastcancer.org and select the "Form a Team" button and pick your team name.
NOTE: We recommend the team name be the company name followed by a tag line.
2. After the captain of your team registers, team members will then visit www.bowlingforbreastcancer.org and select the "Join a Team" button.
3. All team members will be able to create an online fundraising page. Personalize your page, set a realistic but challenging fundraising target (\$100, \$300, \$500) and send your page to family and friends so they can sponsor you directly using a credit card online. (It's safe and secure.)
4. Spread the word about the event and how you're helping Breastcancer.org by raising funds. Refer people back to www.bowlingforbreastcancer.org to learn more.
